Activities don't just pass time... They help the person living with dementia to retain or sometimes regain important skills and provide enjoyment and social contact. Recent research has shown that relatively short periods of shared activity and social interaction achieved a 25% improvement in behavioural symptoms.

Encouraging someone with dementia to do something creative, some gentle exercise, or take part in an activity helps them to realise their potential, which improves their selfesteem and reduces loneliness. Our activities are personalised to the person's current interests, previous occupation and interests, and current cognitive function and abilities.
